

Upcoming Projects:

PG&E Re-powering Project: \$250 million project with \$30 million in construction payroll. Expect construction to start January 2009 and completion summer 2010. Project will require 240 – 280 workers at its peak, average workforce during construction approx 100.

Demolition of parts of the existing facility will begin early 2009 with completion expected in 2015.

Cal Trans:

Mad River Bridges: \$39 million project that will replace and widen 2 bridges on Highway 101 at McKinleyville. Construction will begin Spring 2009 - Completion 2013. This project will be active for 4 construction seasons due to river restraints and fish protection. 11% under engineer's estimate.

Alton Interchange: \$14.5 million project to allow for safe access at Highway 101 & Rt. 36. Construction to begin Spring 2009 - Completion 2012.

Redcrest Sink: \$8.9 million restoration project – Gordon Ball Construction – begins spring 2009. 28% below engineer's estimate.

4 Bridges on Rt 169 in the Hoopa area: 12.2 million \$ project expected to begin construction summer 2009 and expected to take 3 seasons.

In Del Norte County the South Fork Smith River Bridges: 11 - \$16 million - bids Dec 4, 2008.

HSU - New Student Housing: \$38 million dormitory and soccer field. Construction to begin Spring 2009.

HSU – Schatz Energy Research Center: \$2.5 million project.

College of the Redwoods – New Student Union: \$7.6 million project beginning Spring 2009. This is the first of 4 buildings being replaced at the campus due to new seismic regulations.

St Joseph's Hospital: \$64 million hospital addition ongoing. Completion in November 2010.

Blue Lake Casino Hotel: 4 story 144 room hotel will bring approx 40 construction jobs, expect completion summer 2009.

Hampton Inn: bidding in December 2008
